


We got our chef hats on for our Italian inspired MasterChef where we made pizzas and sprinkle cookies!

We laced our joggers for a day full of fun and tiring sporting games. The boys and girls tested their basketball, tennis, soccer and netball skills through drills and games.








Incursions




Book Lovers


